

COOKIE CARAMEL APPLES



5 apples (1-1/2 lb.), washed, well dried

1 pkg. (14 oz.) Caramels

2 Tbsp. water

12 chocolate sandwich cookies, coarsely chopped

½ cup white chocolate chips 5 sticks or wooden popsicle sticks

Insert stick into stem end of each apple.

Cook caramels and water in saucepan on medium-low heat until caramels are melted, stirring frequently. Dip apples, 1 at a time, in caramel, then spoon enough of the caramel over apple until completely coated. Roll in chopped cookies, pressing cookies gently into caramel to secure. Place on waxed-paper-covered baking sheet; let stand 25 min. or until caramel is firm. Melt chocolate as directed on package. Cool 15 min. Drizzle over apples; let stand 10 min. or until firm.

SOPHIA'S SUPER SCARY TACO DIP

1 jar salsa

1 pkg. taco seasoning

3-5 fake spiders

1 can refried beans

1 16 oz. sour cream

1.5 cups shredded cheddar

black olives and jalapenos, all diced,

Spread beans on bottom of pie plate. Spread salsa on top. Place 1/4 cup of sour cream in a plastic bag. Mix the rest of sour cream and taco seasoning together, spread on top of salsa and sprinkle on the cheddar, black olives and jalapenos. Snip the corner of baggy and draw 4 to 5 circles inside each other, from the outside to the center. Draw toothpick from the center out to create a web. Top with fake spiders. Serve with tortilla chips and veggies.

CREATE SPOOKY EFFECTS FOR HALLOWEEN

(Metro) Halloween is a great time to explore your creative side, especially when it comes to decorating for trick-or-treaters or planning a party. Many special spooky effects can be used to create the scary, intimidating atmosphere you desire.

 Dry ice: Dry ice is the solid form of carbon dioxide. It is a good coolant because it can reach temperatures below that of ice and it will not leave a puddle or damp residue behind. Dry ice changes from a solid to a gas with no liquid form, through a process of sublimation. Place dry ice in punch bowls or beverage glasses. Or use dry ice in any other liquid to create billowing plumes of vapor that add to the spooky effects. Just be sure to handle dry ice very carefully and make sure it is inaccessible to curious kids.

Smoke machine: Rent or purchase smoke machines,

which can be found at party stores or big box retailers, to add to your eerie atmosphere. Dim the lights and have smoke rolling through the party room or by the front door.

- Lightning and thunder kits: These kits combine strobe lights or lighting effects with sound systems to simulate the sounds and sights of a thunderstorm.
- Faux cobwebs: Purchase spiderweb kits at retailers or make your own with cotton. Pure cotton balls can be pulled apart and stretched over various items in the house to create a spiderweb effect.
- Accent lighting: Drape a nonflammable piece of fabric over a lampshade to cast different hues around a room. This also dims the brightness in the room, creating shadows here and there. Or, try colored light bulbs and black light for difference looks!

VLAD'S REDNECK SANGRIA

1 bottle of inexpensive red table wine, chilled equal amount of fruit punch, chilled


1 12 oz can of citrus soda, chilled (diet ok) 1-2 cups diced fruit (apples, grapes, melon, berries)

Combine liquids in a pitcher or punch bowl and add fruit. To serve: pour over a glass of ice. Fun Ideas: Dip wine glasses in a saucer of grenadine

and serve with a straw. Try Sunny D instead of Fruit Punch for a different flavor. Thread some of the fruit on a toothpick for a garnish.
